Many have asked why Edgar's VISA is being denied. Basically when a foreigner steps into the U.S. Embassy to solicit a visa, they are guilty until proven innocent. With all the documents in the world, you can still be denied if they have any doubt that you may stay illegally in the states.

LADO has sent an appeal to the Embassy and we are working to submit my Costa Rican residency papers. Since Edgar now has his residency, he can request mine. After submitting the papers, it takes

three months to get the residency. This is the only other document (that we know of) that can prove that we truly *are* returning to CR after our visit.

We are currently receiving a quarter of our needed monthly budget. We are limited financially, but want to continue to serve the Lord with all we are and all we have. He knows our need and He *is* faithful. He does more than we could *ever* ask for or imagine. He is *more* than able, so we wait and rest in Him.
